



Street Resurfacing Forest Hill Area

The City of Richmond Department of Public Works will resurface streets in the Forest Hill area beginning today. This operation should be completed in approximately 3 to 4 weeks. The resurfacing program in your area will be broken down into 2 phases:

1. Milling, patching, and leveling old pavement as needed
2. Slurry application – applying an emulsified asphalt to extend pavement life, provide a smooth riding surface, and improve the overall aesthetics

Phase 1, as noted above, will occur as much as possible after hours to minimize any disruption and inconvenience.
